

Security Settings for Microsoft Explorer

If the security settings for **Internet Explorer** are not set for accessing a secure web page

The lower left hand corner of the Browser will display an icon with the wording “**! Error on page.**” Or it may show a **yellow error icon** and say “**! Done**”.

If so, set the **Internet Explorer** settings to the following.

Click on “**Tools**”

Then click on “**Internet Options**” at the bottom of the list.

Then click on the “**Advanced**” tab.

Move the scroll bar all the way to the bottom.

Place a **Check Mark** on the box next to “**Do not save encrypted pages to disk**”

And

Place a **Check Mark** on the box next to “**Empty Temporary Internet Files folder when browser is closed**”

Then click on the “**Apply**” tab button at the bottom of the window.

Then click on the “**OK**” tab button to exit the window.

Close down **Internet Explorer** and re-open it.
